

Guidelines for Students

It is hoped that by choosing to attend summer school, you will earn the credits you require and improve your ability to meet the demands of high school.

A team of highly conscientious and caring teachers is ready to help you meet these goals. They have prepared a program of activities intended to assist you in achieving two objectives: improving your mark in the course for which you have enrolled and giving you a positive start to the new school year.

We are aware that all of these preparations and good intentions could be derailed by failure on your part to follow certain sets of behaviour. Guidelines for your personal success are outlined briefly below. We trust you will respond positively to them.

Attendance Matters

Summer school classes are intensive learning opportunities. Attendance is compulsory, and evaluation activities are scheduled every day. Parents/guardians will be notified of unexcused absences. Students may be withdrawn after three days of unexcused absence, without refund of fee.

Assignments/Tests

You are expected to complete all assignments and write all tests as scheduled by your teacher.

Code of Conduct

You are expected to dress appropriately. Hats and beach clothing are not acceptable.

You are expected to refrain from smoking anywhere on school property.

You are expected to take care of textbooks and other instructional material or equipment allocated to you and return these items to your teacher at the conclusion of summer school.

Daily Routine

You will receive a five-minute break at approximately 9:30 a.m. and 11:45 a.m. each day, depending on the time slot in which you are registered. You are expected to remain on the school grounds during this break time.

In Case of Illness

In case you become ill while you are in school, you are expected to report first to your class teacher, then to the office. You should not leave the school without first reporting to the office.

Personal Items

The school lockers are not available for use by summer school students.

MP3 and MP4 players, iPods and cell phones cannot be used in the classroom.

You are responsible for the safekeeping of all personal items. Should you happen to lose any personal belongings (e.g., bicycle) you are responsible for notifying the appropriate authorities (police and your insurance company) immediately upon discovering the loss. Textbooks given to you for use during the Summer School must be returned in the same condition as you received them. Any damage or loss will necessitate reimbursement to the Summer School.

Time Slots

Slot 1: 8:00–10:40 a.m.
 Slot 2: 10:40 a.m.–1:20 p.m.
 Subject to sufficient enrolment, courses will be offered in one or both of these time slots.
 Please note: Students may enroll in two courses, but their acceptance is subject to timetable considerations.
 Slot 3: 8:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. (non-repeater courses)

Fees

\$180 per repeater course
 \$360 per non-repeater course (Phys Ed 40S is \$250)
 Fees must be included with the completed application form. Make cheques payable to:
 River East Transcona School Division. Do not send cash in the mail. There will be a charge for NSF cheques.

Registration Deadline: Noon, June 30th

Registrations will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Students should register early to improve their chance of getting a preferred course/time slot. Mail or drop off applications for summer school to: Adult and Continuing Education Office, 530 McLeod Ave., Winnipeg, MB, R2K 0B5. Late registrations will be accepted up to the Second day of classes, i.e. July 6th, subject to availability. Applicants will be assessed a late fee of \$10. Repeater students must have completed the course with a grade above 35 per cent as verified by a report card. Non-repeater courses are available to students who have successfully completed their Grade 11 course requirements, and with school authorization.

Course Cancellations

River East Transcona School Division reserves the right to cancel courses for which there is insufficient enrolment. This means a course could be cancelled outright and the student will receive a full refund. It could also mean a course will be offered in one time slot only and therefore, a student who has registered for a course, for example in Slot 1, may be placed in Slot 2 for that course. If the re-scheduling does not suit the student, he/she will receive a full refund.

Refunds/Withdrawal Deadline: Wednesday, July 7th

To receive a refund, the student must withdraw from the course by July 7th. To apply for a refund, the student must present their receipt, along with a letter from their parent or guardian indicating the reason for withdrawing, to the summer school office located in John Pritchard School. An administrative fee of \$20 will be deducted regardless whether or not the student has attended any classes.

Parent-Teacher Meeting: Wednesday, July 14th

Parent-teacher meetings will be held the morning of July 14, 2010. More details about this event will be sent home with students during the first week summer school is in session.

Report Cards

Report cards will be mailed to the home immediately following the conclusion of summer school. Copies of the reports will also be forwarded to the “sending” and “receiving” school, respectively.
